Jonathan Schaeffer is a professor of Computing Science at the University of Alberta, and is currently the Vice Provost and Associate Vice President for Information Technology. He is the iCORE Chair in High-Performance Artificial Intelligence Systems. His research in artificial intelligence is best known for his work on computer games. He is the creator of the checkers program Chinook, the first program to win a human world championship in any game. He is a co-founder of BioTools (bioinformatics software and the popular Poker Academy).
